# What is included (per 2 weeks)

#### Lessons

- 3 hours of STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Maths) per week

- 2 full day trips by private coach with entrance and ATC staff
- 2 half day trips with entrance and ATC staff (1 by public transport, 1 by private coach)
- · 2 half day walking activities off campus with ATC staff, without entrance (including Bray walking orientation tour)
- 1 full day trip with ATC staff, without entrance to greater Dublin area by public transport

#### **Accommodation**

- Host family accommodation, 2-4 students per family
- Full board accommodation
- Families are located from 5 to 55 minutes walking distance to the school, average walking distance is approx. 35 mins and all students have a Travel Pass (LEAP Card) included in their programme
