



Effective English Training for Adults

Students are individuals

We develop our own syllabus, thoroughly road-tested over the years, regularly updated, and reviewed multiple times by the British Council. This has been proven to deliver more of a student-centred learning experience than following a textbook. In other words, after establishing students' individual needs, our teachers design student-centred lessons that focus on the language weaknesses and goals of the learners in the class. We aim to get as close as possible to the tailored experience of a one-to-one lesson within our group classes – a much more tailored experience than many schools can offer.

Progress is clear

From day one we build a Learner Profile for each student using our own placement test and needs analysis information. Students have weekly progress checks and regular personal tutorials with our Director of Studies, to target learning goals in a timely and precise way. Students' progress is assessed on what they can do with English as well as what they know. Each student has a personalised student portal with helpful comments from their teachers and regular tracking of their progress through the CEFR language levels, using our English Score System.

Your First Day

If you haven't done our online placement test before you arrive at the school, we will ask you to do a short written test to accurately determine your level. You will then be met by the Director of Studies for a short interview to decide on the most suitable class for you. A member of our staff will give you a full induction, including a tour of the school and a copy of the Student Handbook, with useful information about your course, exams, tips for learning English after class and much more, to guide you through your foreign experience.

Materials

Our syllabus is designed to be flexible, allowing our teachers to meet the student's needs no matter when they come through our doors. Content is regularly updated to include the needs of each individual student. Every lesson uses a range of resource books, workbooks, audio, video and web materials. We do not believe in limiting our students to one set of materials, so you will not have to buy a particular coursebook. All materials are included in the course fees.

Progress

During the course, your progress in all the skills will be checked weekly. Every month, you will have an individual tutorial with the Director of Studies to discuss progress, set goals and make plans for the next stage of the course. You will have your own unique Learner Profile in which the teacher tracks weekly progress and offers advice.

Certificates

Besides having the opportunity to earn a TELC certificate at the end of the course, students will also receive a KKCL certificate with a statement of their overall CEFR.

General English One To One

A One To One lesson is individual tuition where the topics of the lesson are decided between the teacher and the student. In each session, the teacher can focus intensively on areas and skills specific to the learner, making it a very popular option for students who need to make progress quickly.

This is a tailor-made, intensive and highly personalised programme to meet your needs and help you achieve your objectives. Working with your own personal teacher will maximise your speaking time and offer opportunities for correction of your errors.

We offer One To One courses in General English as well as many professional areas. The programme can also be combined with group General English courses. All materials are included in the course fees. Please note: We insist on two hours as the minimum time for a single booking, and generally would recommend against any One To One session which lasts for longer than three hours.

IELTS is arguably the world's most recognised English exam, testing proficiency across all levels. It is run by Cambridge ESOL, IDP Education Australia and the British Council. Obtaining a high score in IELTS gives students access to a range of new education, immigration and employment opportunities around the world.

The exam comprises Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking sections and is available in two forms, General and Academic.

Academic IELTS

The Academic paper is for those who want to attend university in an English-speaking country. It is also a requirement for certain professions – such as medical workers – who wish to work in an English-speaking country.

General IELTS

The General paper is not taken as often as the Academic, and is usually for those who want to gain an English language qualification for general work experience, or wish to migrate to an English-speaking country.

Trinity's GESE exam tests English speaking and listening skills through a 1:1 interview with a Trinity examiner. There are 12 grades, grouped into the following four stages:

- Initial (Grades 1-3)
- Elementary (Grades 4-6)
- Intermediate (Grades 7-9)
- Advanced (Grades 10-12)

Cambridge Exams

Cambridge exams assess learner's speaking, listening, reading and writing skills in real-life situations. There are different Cambridge exams for each CEFR level: KET (A1-A2, Elementary), PET (B1, Intermediate), FCE (B2, Upper-Intermediate), CAE (C1, Advanced) and CPE (C2, Proficiency).

Levels

We offer Business English to students studying at B1 and above. If you have an English level of A2 or lower, we recommend that you study General English before moving on to speciality Business English.

Progress

Certificates

Our English courses can be added as part of this Work Experience Programme, allowing students to study an English course at our Harrow school and participate in our part-time Work Experience Programme at the same time.


Tailor-made Programme for students

Focused English lessons can be arranged in conjunction with the work experience programme. For Erasmus+ students, we offer dedicated vocational English exams in the school, along with engaging work experience and industry visits.

It is possible to do exam preparation alongside the work placement, which will not only bridge the gap between the class and the exam but also prepare students to use English in real-world situations.

All English lessons take place inside KKCL's Grade II listed building, with its modern facilities including a cafeteria, free Wi-Fi, an IT lab and a relaxing student lounge. As an examination centre for Trinity, Language Cert and TELC, we know these exams inside-out, so your students will be very well prepared for the big day.

We offer TELC (The European Language Certificates) exams in fields as diverse as Business, Hotel & Restaurant and Technical English for Engineers. Approved by the Association of Language Teachers in Europe and based on the real-world communication skills set out in the Common European Framework of Reference, TELC is a truly reliable statement of a student's language proficiency.

Vocational Skills Workshop / Seminars

In addition to our English courses, we also offer industry-related workshops and seminars. These give students valuable insight into their chosen fields, while factory visits give a fascinating glimpse into the inner workings of some of the world's most famous corporations.

Student Support and Welfare

KKCL has comprehensive welfare policies and procedures – reviewed by both the British Council and the Independent Schools Inspectorate – and a team of dedicated staff who do their very best to ensure the safety and well-being of our students. Students carry a 24-hour emergency telephone number at all times.

Our Work Experience Officers are here to assist students and group leaders throughout the entire programme, from pre-arrival preparation to the final performance review. In each workplace, there will be one main contact person who is responsible for introducing the students to their working role and supporting them where needed as their Line Manager.

We will also provide preparatory material as part of the induction on arrival, and our Work Experience Officer will be on hand to give practical advice on how to deal with different situations in the workplace. One To One mentoring sessions at KKCL will be scheduled to ensure all the students are settling in and given helpful guidance on how to be successful within their chosen role.

What is Erasmus+?

Erasmus+ is the EU funding programme for education, training, youth and sport, and replaces all previous funding programmes such as Comenius, Leonardo Da Vinci and Grundtvig. As part of the Lifelong Learning Programme, grants are available to enable students to participate in a work experience programme in a country other than the country in which they normally live. This funding is administered by National Agencies who represent the European Commission in each EU member state.

All Erasmus+ applications must be made through your school or institution, and can only be made provided they have a partner abroad who is able to receive their students. Individual grants are still available, but the application must go through your school.

Within the EU Funded Professional Development Programme we offer a selection of courses for English and Subject Teachers, School Managers and Administrative Staff. Our courses are aimed at staff at all stages of education (primary, secondary, vocational and adult education), and have been developed to help participants grow professionally by exploring their own experience, and sharing ideas with colleagues from other European countries.

We offer Professional Development courses throughout the year with set dates for individual bookings in international groups. Closed group courses can be organised at any time.

Courses are one or two weeks, Monday to Friday. We offer help with accommodation and provide you with a 24 hour emergency number during your stay at KKC

Full Induction

Upon arrival, new students receive the KKCL welcome pack before being taken on an induction tour of the college. They are also informed about the social activities, welfare and support available.

- Local police registration for visa nationals
- Opening a UK bank account
- Finding work (where to look for jobs, working rights etc.)

Our staff are extensively trained in first aid, fire safety, GDPR, as well as having trained to relevant and/or specialist level in Safeguarding. We always have a first-aid trained staff member on hand, and at least one fire safety officer in the building at all times.

KKCL is a Bully Free Zone and we operate a zero-tolerance policy for all students and adults. Throughout our centres, we use notice boards and posters to inform students of who to speak to if they have any concerns or worries. Even if it is a common problem such as homesickness, KKCL staff are trained in how to listen and help in different situations, so that the student is able to enjoy their KKCL experience. Our staff are friendly and approachable and support students if they have any worries or concerns.

Our flagship school is in a listed building and we currently do not have full provision for disabled and wheelchair access, but we are working towards improvements in this area.
